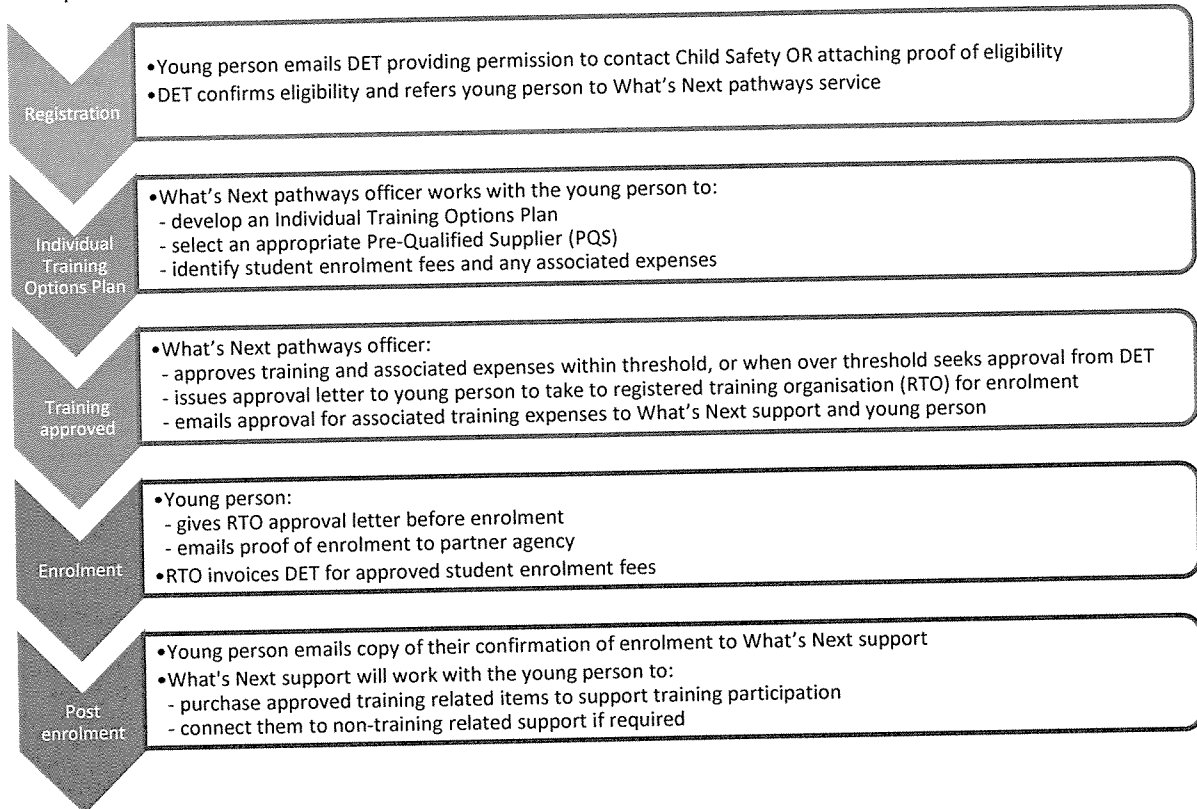


Application process

The process to access support from the What's Next OOHC fund appears below:



Registration is open until **31 May 2018**

- To register for the fund the young person must email WhatsNextOOHC@det.qld.gov.au providing their first name, last name, age and postcode. They must also provide proof of out-of-home care eligibility. This may include one of the following:
 - an email confirming your care experience from a Child Safety Officer or Child Safety Service Centre; or
 - an email confirming your care experience from a support agency e.g. CREATE Foundation, *Next Step After Care*, Youth Advocacy Centre; or
 - permission for DET to confirm with Child Safety that they been in out-of-home care in Queensland including first name, last name, gender and date of

birth as it would appear in records held by Child Safety.

DET may seek permission from the young person to contact Child Safety if there is insufficient evidence provided and/or any clarification is considered necessary.

- The young person will be contacted within five working days of their application to commence development of their individual training options plan which may include a career assessment as a first step.
- Young people who are not eligible for the fund will be notified via email within five working days of receipt of their application.
- Once eligibility is confirmed, a young person can apply to the fund again for training identified in their individual training options plan, which can be updated at any time.
